SUNDAY JUNE 1

BIKE WEEK KICKOFF BEACH PARTY & RIDE • 3PM

Starting Location: Haymarket Plaza, Meet between 2-3pm

MONDAY JUNE 2

CORBA GROUP RIDE • ARRIVE AT 5:45PM • RIDE AT 6PM

Starting Location: Lowes Creek County Park, East Gate Entrance off Lorch Ave
